Shabbona Hometown Events Committee Business Meeting Minutes

Old Business:

Cubs trip – Game day is April 2nd, all tickets were sold very quickly at a price of \$55 each. The profit is now at \$726 for this fundraiser.

Jamie's goal is to have \$3,000 in the checking account on 1/1/2012 to start off the next year.

Sponsor donations received through today are \$2,585. Thank you letters are being sent out as soon as donations are received.

Daddy Daughter Dance – Only 2 pre-sale tickets have been sold so far. Dawn Kimpflin will drop off some tickets at the schools to help with pre-sales. The dance will be held at the grade school on Saturday, April 30th. Supplies for the dance will be purchased at GFS, but everyone will contribute by making cookies. Details will be worked out before the dance.

Mother & Son "Fun Day on a Sunday" – To be held on Sunday, May 22nd. Supplies will also be purchased at GFS.

The committee reviewed the schedule for the Fourth of July weekend. The parade is at 10 a.m. Vicki has sent out a mailing.

NIU Huskies game – Cindy is looking into getting tickets as a fall fundraiser. Profit would be made from ticket sales only (\$500 potential.) Transportation & tailgating will not be included.

A Santa bake sale is another potential fundraiser we may consider to keep our name out there year-round.

501(c)3 – Michelle has filled out the paperwork, the cost will be \$400.

New Business:

We will again go to the schools for the T-shirt design using our theme "Everybody's Hometown." Jamie & Dawn will submit the rules for the contest to the schools.

Dawn has been talking to the FFA, who may provide a petting zoo during the Fourth of July activities for a donation of \$100. We may also need to provide a couple workers. Dawn will follow up with them next week.

There is some paperwork that needs to be filed for the parade. Dawn & Jamie will take care of this.

Dawn, Cindy & Stephony are in charge of advertising. This includes making signs for gold star sponsors, school newsletters, radio station and newspaper announcements, and posting flyers. Another flyer will be mailed in June listing the Fourth of July schedule.

Dawn will get trophies for the bags tournament & water fights.

We will hold a 50/50 raffle this year. Ticket prices will be 1 for \$5, or 3 for \$10. Sales will start at the daddy/daughter dance.

The Hometown Citizen form is on the website. The deadline for entries is June 11, 2011.

Joann Pardridge donated a quilt & pillow for us to raffle.
