## Shabbona Hometown Events Committee

### Business Meeting Minutes

**Date:** 05/20/11

President Jamie Deutsch called the regular meeting of the Shabbona Hometown Events Committee to order at 7:00 p.m. The minutes and Finance Reports of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Minutes Approved – Motion by Jamie Deutsch, Second by Cindy Deutsch, all in favor

Treasurer's Report – unofficial report reviewed. It was noted that we had received an NSF check from someone at the daddy-daughter dance. Jamie has attempted to contact this person twice with no results. Jamie does not believe an NSF has been charged to us. The checking balance is \$4,278.77.

#### Old Business:

Sponsor donations received through today are \$4,110 (plus another \$750 promised.) More donations are expected after the June mailing.

Daddy Daughter Dance – The dance went well. There were issues with some of the music selection not being appropriate for the age groups in attendance. It was suggested that next year we should contact Wal-Mart to possibly donate the cookies.

T-shirt Design Contest – a winner had to be selected before this meeting date so that the pizza party could be awarded while school was still in session. There were two winners, Olivia Turner & Devon Probst. Francesca's donated 4 pizzas and pop. Screamers Ice Cream donated sundae certificates. A cash prize of \$25 was given to each winner.

Jamie will talk to Screamer's Ice Cream about donating ice cream for the ice cream eating contest. Cindy suggested making a sponsor sign to be displayed at the contest.

Mother & Son "Fun Day on a Sunday" – Jamie is buying supplies. Games were discussed, plus possible cancellation due to lack of interest from the community. Supplies could be used at the bags tournament. The event is scheduled for noon this Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

A Moon Jump 4 u will set up at 7am on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. The parade will begin at 10am. Vendors will be open 10am-4pm. Cindy only has 2 vendors, needs help. Dawn still has not received confirmation from the FFA regarding the petting zoo, but she has talked to Vicky Drendal who thought she might be able to do something.

Santa Bake Sale – If we do this event, Cindy has a referral for a Santa. He would need to be booked by September.

501(c)3 – After much review of the paperwork, we have decided not to file. The paperwork for the parade has been filed. Thank you Jamie and Dawn.

#### New Business:

There was discussion on the June mailing. Jamie shared a sample copy. Cindy suggested that we also do a flyer with just the event schedule to be displayed at local businesses & at the campground. Jamie agreed. We need to start getting people lined up to sit in the dunk tank. It would be a good idea to have these names listed on the schedule.

T-shirt order – Jamie showed a sample of the layout of the shirt back. He will put together a small order through Petfish Joe. T-shirts will be given to the design winners and may be given to sponsors. We will use neon yellow for staff shirts.

Cindy and Stephony will make sure signs are made for the Gold sponsors to be displayed at the rides.

Jamie will order the banner and yard signs from Banner up as long as they have the best prices. Dawn will find out how many yard signs we still have and can re-use. She thinks around 15.

Dawn will talk to Beth Einsele to have the request for Hometown Citizen nominations displayed on the sign.

Quilt – We will set up a separate table to display the quilt donated by Joann Pardridge. We will sell quilt raffle tickets at \$2 each. Dawn suggested buying a second tent to be used for this and face painting.
