Business Meeting Minutes

President Jamie Deutsch called the regular meeting of the Shabbona Hometown Events Committee to order at 3:25 p.m. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Minutes Approved – Motion by Jamie Deutsch, Second by Cindy Deutsch, all in favor

Treasurer's Report – unofficial report reviewed. The checking balance is \$5,676.08. Approved by Dawn Kimpflin, Second by Dwight Gosnell, all in favor.

Old Business:

Sponsor donations received through today are \$6,749.95. Donations are a lot higher this year, as was the profit from the Cubs trip. Jamie does not expect as much from softball this year, however. Our goal remains to start next year with \$3,000, though we should exceed that amount. Jamie would like to have seen more 'Hometown' category sponsors, but donations were better this year than in previous years.

The wristband price will remain at \$5. We would like to keep the cost low for the community, plus it will be easier to make change.

Daddy Daughter Dance – The committee received a cleaning bill from the school for \$205, plus they kept our \$50 deposit. Jamie paid the bill, but also included a letter expressing his disappointment since everyone on the committee stayed to clean the gym and probably left it in better condition than when we arrived. They charged us for clearing out the smoke from the smoke machine used by the DJ. We ended up losing money on this fundraiser because of this bill.

Dan Nolan was presented with the Hometown Citizen Award. He was very honored and agreed to be grand marshal of the parade. Jamie will contact Beth Einsele to have this announced on the town sign.

The t-shirts winners have agreed to carry the banner in the parade & Jamie has arranged for someone to carry the flag. Vicki had no updates, but Jamie thinks the parade is coming together well.

Vendors/Crafters – we currently have seven booths, two are food vendors. The committee was again encouraged to ask anyone they knew who might be interested in setting up a booth.

Jamie prepared the tri-fold brochures that will be placed in the local businesses & possibly put in the doors of local residences.

The t-shirts have been ordered from PetFish Joe. They will be in Wednesday. Jamie is pleased with the way they turned out.
