## Shabbona Hometown Events Committee Business Meeting Minutes

President Jamie Deutsch called the regular meeting of the Shabbona Hometown Events Committee to order at 6:00 p.m.

Minutes approved – Motion by Jamie Deutsch, Second by Cindy Deutsch, all in favor.

Treasurer's Report – Sponsor total at \$4,605 which is good progress compared to last year's total of 6,700. Financial report approved with motion by Cindy Deutsch, Second by Dawn Kimpflin, all in favor.

### Old Business:

The February mailing went out as scheduled to 1700 postal customers.

### New Business:

Cubs Bus Trip – Need to sell tickets. Only half sold to date. Cindy votes that we do not schedule any more Friday games.

Daddy/ Daughter Dance – Starts at 6pm on April 28<sup>th</sup> at the Shabbona Fire Department. We will meet at the fire dept. at 2pm that day to set up. Derek & TJ will be our DJ's using our new equipment. Dawn asked that everyone bring string lights of any kind or color for decoration. Ideas discussed: pass out tiaras, raffle a gift basket, no 50/50 raffle, and use red table cover for a 'red carpet' effect. Cookies, juice & popcorn will be provided. Dawn is going to GFS to purchase supplies.

T-Shirt Design – Dawn will drop off the rules at the school this week, using a deadline of April 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a \$50 cash prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place with a pizza party. We will talk to Screamer's about donating sundae gift certificates again for runner-up prizes.

Vendors – Seven (7) vendors signed up so far. Discussed the option of having a third food vendor, but voted to pass because of the small venue and keeping the vendors local.

Moon jumps – Total bill for moon jumps is \$4,200. This can be adjusted if needed. We will need to man 6-7 stations plus the ticket tent. Photos of the jumps reserved were passed around. Includes a 'toilet flush' which will replace the dunk tank as there were too many complaints of injury last year. Tickets for the flush will be \$1 per flush, not included in the wrist-band entry price.

Parade – Due to construction on Pontiac Street, the parade will have to be cut short at Illini. Members voted to pass an offer from the Tebala Shriners to participate, as the \$550 cost seemed excessive. Vicki announced that Mr. Feken has agreed to have Indian Creek participate this year after being told (not the first time) that they could play their instruments riding on a float without having to wear uniforms. A clown has been hired to walk the parade and will stay during the activities to pass out balloons, total cost \$100. Trophies will be given out for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place entries, no cash prize.

Petting Zoo – Dawn will follow up, but was told a petting zoo would be provided this year.

The next mailing will go out in May along with tri-folds displaying the weekend schedule of activities.

Softball – Jamie discussed how the insurance for our softball fundraiser might be almost half the cost as last year.

Motion made by Michelle Gosnell, seconded by Cindy Deutsch to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m. (Shortest meeting ever!) Minutes taken by Kathy Feltz
